Manitoga/Russel Wright Center Designated National Historic Landmark

Kelly, Tamagna, Manitoga Board Members Worked Together to Achieve Designation

U.S. Congresswoman Sue Kelly, Putnam County Legislator Vinny Tamagna, and Board Members at the Manitoga/The Russel Wright Design Center announced last week that the Garrison site has been designated a National Historic Landmark.

A National Historic Landmark designation is the highest national recognition that can be obtained for a historic property. Manitoga becomes the first National Historic Landmark in Putnam County.

Manitoga preserves the legacy of Russel Wright, a nationally renowned designer in the mid-20th Century who lived and based his operations at the Garrison location. The site preserves Wright's home and studio along with the unique landscape, his possessions, and archives. Manitoga's 75 acres were thoughtfully designed by Wright over the course of 35 years. The architect for Dragon Rock, Wright's dramatic modern home and studio, was David Leavitt and Wright was the interior designer.

Members worked together to promote the site to the U.S. Department of Interior and National Park Service for National Historic Landmark consideration. The NYS Office of Parks, Recreation & Historic Preservation nominated Manitoga to become a National Historic Landmark. As designated by the Secretary of the Interior, "National Historic Landmarks are nationally significant historic places ... because they possess exceptional value or quality in illustrating or interpreting the heritage of the United States."

A National Historic Landmark designation also enhances a site's prospects for federal funding consideration. Manitoga now qualifies for additional federal assistance opportunities, including federal grants and loans through the National Trust for Historic Preservation that are only available to National Historic Landmark sites.

"With this designation today, Manitoga now ranks among the sites of greatest historical significance in our country," Congresswoman Kelly said. "The extraordinary landscape, architecture, and history of Manitoga make it a Hudson Valley treasure, and these attributes are now being recognized on a national scale. Today marks a celebration of the hard work and cooperative efforts of so many individuals here in Putnam County to preserve the legacy of Manitoga and Russel Wright. Manitoga is an important part of the Putnam County community, and this designation is a valuable boost for our local tourism, cultural, and preservation efforts."

Tamagna said, "It has been my privilege to shepherd Manitoga's application for National Landmark status. It certainly deserves this level of

distinction. I am proud to be a part of the team, with Congresswoman Sue Kelly, to achieve this recognition for Manitoga.”

Manitoga Executive Director Anita Pidala said, “Manitoga is thrilled to receive a National Historic Landmark designation. Being designated a National Historic Landmark will help us achieve our mission and fulfill Wright’s desire to ‘bring American culture an intimacy with nature.’”

Kelly, Tamagna, and Manitoga leaders also worked together to secure a \$250,000 federal grant in October 2005 through the Save America’s Treasures initiative to benefit preservation efforts at the site.

Manitoga is one of only a few 20th century modern home sites in New York that are open to the public. It was recently designated as an official site of the First Lady’s Preserve America initiative. Manitoga is a member of Historic Artists’ Homes and Studios, a program of the National Trust for Historic Preservation. It also is recognized as a Heritage Site of the Hudson River Valley National Heritage Area, and is part of the Hudson River Greenway Trail System.

“I am pleased to designate Manitoga as a National Historic Landmark,” U.S. Secretary of the Interior Gale A. Norton said in a statement today. “The people of Putnam County have reason to be proud of the work produced by Russel Wright at Manitoga.”
