## Cold Spring To Hold Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for New Trolleys

The Village of Cold Spring got a sneak peek of the new trolleys that will be operating in the Village this summer on Memorial Day this past Monday when they chaffered Veterans during the parade. Regular service will begin on Saturday, June 3rd with a ribbon cutting ceremony at noon at lower Main Street in the Village.

"The trolleys will be a boon to our economy and to tourism," said Putnam County Legislator Vincent Tamagna who was instrumental, along with Congresswoman Sue Kelly, in securing the funding for the trolleys. "As a "Preserve America" community, visitors can visit all eight designated historic sites, such as Boscobel and Manitoaga and explore all the beauty our Hudson River area has to offer all for only a dime! Thursdays through Sundays starting from lower Main Street in Cold Spring with stops at points of interest along the way.
