**Bio:** Born in Meriden, Connecticut, Agnes Hart studied at the Ringling School of Art in Sarasota, Florida and at Iowa State University. She studied alongside Josef Fresser, Paul Burlin, Lucile Blanch, and also studied printmaking with Reginald Neal. After graduating from Iowa State, Hart went to New York to study at the Art Students League. She exhibited her work at the Roko Gallery in Woodstock, New York in 1949, 1951, 1955, 1959, 1963, and 1972. She also presented a show at the Woodstock Artists Association in 1953. In addition, she exhibited at Mercer University in Georgia in 1962 and at Coral Gables, Florida in 1973.
