

# Life on the Fulton-Gallagher Farm in the 1920s

The originals of these photographs are owned by Harriet Norton of Red Hook, New York. They show life on the Fulton-Gallagher Farm on Turkey Hill Road east of Upper Red Hook in the 1920s. John Fulton was the first owner of the farm according to a deed of 1795. He was Harriet's maternal grandfather.
